

Mazda RX-8 is available in two versions, delivering either 192 ps or 231 ps. Both with 18" alloys, climate control air conditioning, premium Bose audio with 6-CD autochanger and front fog lights. Optional equipment includes leather upholstery, DVD satellite navigation (which is only available when purchasing leather), electric sunroof and metallic paint.

In a rotary engine a triangular-shaped rotor sweeps the fuel/air mix along with each part of the combustion process occurring in a different section of the engine housing.

It's quiet. The only sound is the gentle sway of grass in the breeze... Now the wind carries a new sound. Something different. Something exciting. It's getting closer. Suddenly the unforgettable sound of Mazda RX-8 introduces itself.

Much smaller and lighter than a conventional piston engine, all the parts of a rotary engine spin around a central shaft, there is no up and down piston movement. So as combustion occurs, the rotor immediately turns, increasing potential engine revs with virtually no vibration. And because rotary engines only have three main moving parts, compared with at least forty in even the simplest piston engine, power delivery is incredibly smooth and refined.


There are two RENESIS engines to choose from: 231 ps (170 kW) @ 8200 rpm with a 9000 rpm limit, or 192 ps (141 kW) @ 7000 rpm with a 7500 rpm limit, both delivering smooth acceleration and exhilarating power output. You'll never hear or experience anything quite like Mazda RX-8.

With the uniquely compact RENESIS engine at its heart, Mazda's engineers had everything they needed to create a car that looks and sounds like no other. But how does it feel to drive?

Exciting and exceptionally agile, Mazda RX-8 responds almost intuitively to every movement and action you make. Its entire powertrain is mounted low behind the front axle to create near perfect 50/50 weight distribution and a low centre of gravity. Add to that a fuel tank mounted in front of the rear axle, helping concentrate the weight mass near the centre, the result being 100% pure sports car thrills.

The newly developed double-wishbone front suspension delivers confident, precise control. Which, combined with the new multi-link rear suspension, provides lateral stiffness for superb handling and longitudinal compliance for outstanding stability.



Perfect 50/50 weight distribution has been made possible by the unique location of the powertrain.



Then, there's the Dynamic Stability Control (DSC), giving the driver the reassurance of intelligent handling by applying appropriate brake-force to individual wheels and managing engine output to prevent skids – without compromising the exciting performance. And for greater cornering control, there's the Limited Slip Differential (LSD), which works with the DSC to help maintain traction while accelerating hard.



Door structure:

A reinforced structure in the front edges of the rear doors forms a centre pillar that locks into the roof and floor, increasing body rigidity and side-impact protection.



Body structure:

The strong, high-mount backbone is located in the upper part of the transmission tunnel for enhanced body rigidity.



Strengthening V-brace:

A V-shaped diagonal brace is attached to the top mounting of each rear suspension damper, giving rigid damper support and promoting torsional rigidity at the rear of the body.

The extensive reinforcement of the rear doors creates an integrated B-pillar when the doors are fully closed, significantly improving body side strength and achieving world-class safety performance.

Mazda RX-8 boasts a range of exceptional safety standards: driver's and front passenger airbags with dual-stage deployment as well as side and curtain airbags to protect all occupants. It also features an intrusion-minimising brake pedal to help reduce foot and leg injuries in a frontal collision. In addition, Mazda RX-8 provides class-leading stopping distance enhanced by large diameter disc brakes, an Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) and Electronic Brake-force Distribution (EBD) as standard.

A ring-shaped structural reinforcement around the door opening in each of the body's side panel improves cabin rigidity. These structural reinforcements result in maximum strength and stiffness.

is greatly enhanced by the front-midship layout, which creates a large crumple zone between the engine and the front bumper.



Side SRS airbags and curtain airbags help to ensure passenger safety.



Freestyle doors:

The freestyle doors create an exceptionally large opening for easy access, the front doors open to a maximum of 67° with 80° at the rear.
